## GENERAL RULES

- > The official game ball will be provided by Nikkei Games.
- All bats must be ASA approved. No Miken, Original Synergy, Synergy 2, or Orange Crush.
- Each team should bring their own gloves -- they will not be provided.
- Forfeit time is game time.
- > Umpires will be provided for each game.
- Catcher's mask is optional.
- ➢ Bases are 60 feet apart.
- Each team must have a minimum of 8 players (at least 4 females) to start the game.
- (Defensively), if playing with 4 females a MAXIMUM of 5 males are allowed on the field.
- > Teams must always have a catcher and a pitcher.

The current Southern California Municipal Athletic Federation (SCMAF) Rule Book will govern all play with the following exceptions:

- 1. All games will be 7 innings or 1 hour and 10 minutes of play. No inning will begin with 7 minutes or less remaining in the game.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the captain to verify the innings, times, and the scores with the umpire.
- 3. While a female is batting, the rover can only be a female.
- 4. Courtesy runners shall be the last recorded out made by the player of the same sex.
- 5. No leading off.
- 6. Bunting is not allowed. A bunt will result in an automatic out.
- 7. After having two strikes, a batter is only allowed one foul ball, after which the ball must be hit fair.
- 8. There will be a "mercy rule" of 10 runs per inning maximum, except for the last inning which will be an open inning.
- 9. To speed up play, each batter will automatically begin with a 1&1 count (one ball and one strike).
- 10. If there is a tie at the end of regulation play, extra innings shall begin with a runner on second base (the person who made the last out in the previous inning).
- 11. Free-substitution (defensively) will be allowed throughout the game.
- 12. The batting order must list men and women separately and followed alternately such that two batters of the same sex may never bat consecutively.
